



**Enrique Medina Malo**, Chief Policy Officer, Telefónica

Enrique Medina Malo holds a law degree from Carlos III University of Madrid (1994) and was admitted to the Spanish Government Legal Services in 1997.

He joined Telefónica's Legal department in 2006, as Head of Public Law and then became Head of Telecommunications and Information Society Legal Affairs. In this role, he was responsible for Regulation and Competition legal issues.

In 2008 he was appointed Chief Legal Officer of Telefónica, S.A., reporting to the Group's General Counsel and in September 2011, General Counsel of Telefonica Europe, reporting to the regional CEO.

Before working for Telefónica, he served as State Lawyer for the Spanish State Administration, Ministry of Science and Technology, Ministry of Industry and Energy and the High Court of Cataluña.

From 2002 to 2004 he was appointed General Director for Legislation (Secretario General Técnico) of the Ministry of Science & Technology.

He has also held the role of Chief Legal Officer of the Spanish Broadcasting Corporation RTVE (2004-2006).
